## **NOTICE TO ALL AVIATION STAKEHOLDERS**

The Civil Aviation Authority of Fiji (CAAF) is seeking industry feedback on issuance of the Standards Document for Aerodromes Volume I (Edition 1.0).

The proposed Standards Document – Aerodromes Volume I (Edition 1.0) introduces significant changes, including:

- 1) Amendment 18 to Annex 14, Volume I introduces elements concerning runway strip width for code number 3 runways and erases the geometric discrepancy in the widths of runway strips between the various code numbers for non-instrument (NINST) runways.; and
- 2) ground handling as of 26 November 2026 and obstacle limitation surfaces as of 21 November 2030.

The applicability date for this amendment is **27 November 2025**. The effective date for this amendment is **30 September 2025**.

We invite you to participate in a 4-week consultation process ending **06 Sep 2025**.
